

Social Security Ticket to Work Employment Networks



Find Help to Achieve Your Work Goals

Ticket to Work service providers offer Social Security disability beneficiaries (persons who receive SSI or SSDI) age 18 through 64 who want to work with free job support.

Services offered may include job coaching, job counseling, training, benefits counseling and job placement.

Employment Networks (ENs)

An **Employment Network (EN)** is an entity that enters into an agreement with the Social Security Administration (Social Security) to either provide or coordinate the delivery of services to Social Security disability beneficiaries. Once you connect with the Ticket to Work Program, you can assign your ticket to an EN that meets your needs.
