

Updated COVID-19 Booster Vaccine

Answers to Common Questions



1. Why should I get the updated booster?

The updated boosters will target the original COVID-19 strain, Omicron, and its sub-variants. As a result, it protects against the new strains more effectively than the previous boosters.

2. Can I mix and match vaccine brands?

Yes, you can get either booster dose regardless of the brand of your main vaccine series.

3. Can I get the booster at the same time as the flu shot?

Yes, you can get your booster dose on the same day or even at the same appointment as your regular flu shot.

4. How do I know if I am up to date on the recommended doses of the COVID-19 vaccine?

You are up to date on your COVID-19 vaccinations if you have completed a primary series of COVID-19 vaccinations and received the most recent booster dose recommended for you by the CDC.

If you have recently had COVID-19, you might consider delaying your next dose of vaccine (main or booster) 3 months from the onset of your symptoms or, if you did not have symptoms, from the time you received your test with positive result.
